

# AGX lands three-year air freight and customs services contract from Malaysia Airlines

**AGX** Group Bhd said its wholly owned subsidiary, AGX Logistics (M) Sdn Bhd, has been awarded a tender by Malaysia Airlines Bhd for air freight forwarding and customs brokerage services.

Under the services agreement, AGX will provide air and sea freight forwarding as well as customs brokerage services for the shipment of aircraft parts and other goods related to Malaysia Airlines' operations.

The contract is for a period of three years, effective from Dec 1, 2025 to Nov 30, 2028.

AGX will also provide round-the-clock services for shipments classified as "Aircraft on Ground".

AGX said the appointment aligns with Malaysia Airlines' ongoing efforts to modernise its fleet and enhance operational efficiency, as the national carrier continues to rely on capable maintenance, repair and overhaul and logistics partners to support fleet readiness and compliance requirements.

"This award from MAS expands our portfolio and strengthens AGX's position as a third party logistics solutions provider to the aviation sector. In parallel, the success of our Vietnam-based subsidiary in securing the service agreements with both VietJet and Sun PhuQuoc Airways marks AGX's strategic entry into Vietnam's aviation logistics sector," its Group CEO Datuk Ponnudorai Periasamy said.

He added that the logistics sector is set to expand in tandem with the MRO industry as growing aircraft fleets, more complex supply chains and the need for just-in-time delivery of high-value components drive demand.

Supported by factors such as stronger regional connectivity, the continued recovery in air travel and ongoing fleet expansion across ASEAN, he said, demand for aviation logistics services is expected to remain robust.

AGX said the contract strengthens its long-term strategy and positions the group to capture opportunities arising from growth in the regional aviation logistics and MRO ecosystem.
